

Easter Wrap Can-Can Basket

Crafter level: Easy

Time needed: 15 minutes

What you'll need

- Clean, empty paint can (available at most home improvement stores)
- Measuring tape or ruler
- Roll of wrapping paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- 1-in.-diameter hole punch (optional)
- Glue stick or double stick tape
- Filler for basket



How to make it

1. Measure the paint can's height and circumference. Cut a strip from the gift wrap that's slightly shorter in height and slightly longer in length than the measurements. (Our can was about $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches high and 21 inches in circumference, so we cut our strip to be $7\frac{1}{4}$ by 22 inches in size.)
2. Wrap the paper carefully around the can and mark dots on the gift wrap strip for the handle.
3. Use scissors to cut a slit in the gift wrap to each of the pencil marks. Then use the hole punch or scissors to make holes in the gift wrap at the marks.
4. Wrap the paper around the can, lining up the holes with the handles and tape or glue the paper to the can.
5. Fill can with shredded paper or filler of your choice.
