

Feathered Nest Basket

Crafter level: Easy

Time needed: 30 minutes, not including drying time

What you'll need

- Basket with handle
- Spray paint (we used white)
- Feather boa (available at most crafts stores)
- Low-temp hot glue gun and glue sticks
- 1 yd. marabou feather trim



How to make it

1. In a well-ventilated area, spray paint the inside, outside and handle of the basket in the color of your choice, following the manufacturer's instructions on the can of paint. Let dry.
2. Repeat with a second coat if needed. Then let dry overnight.
3. Below 1 of the handles on the outside of the basket, begin gluing the boa to the basket. Continue gluing the boa to the basket about every 6 inches, making a spiral around the basket with the boa.
4. Glue the marabou feather trim to the top rim of the basket and trim off the excess.

Tasty Twists

- Instead of gluing the boa to the outside of the basket, just place it in the basket for some fancy egg bedding. Then kids can play with the boa when Easter is over.
- Use a yellow boa and create a "chick" basket for your favorite little chick.
