



Choco-nests

These adorably easy-to-make nests are fun to fill with whatever favorite candies you choose.

24 oz. bittersweet or white chocolate chips

12-oz. bag chow mein noodles

Candy eggs or jelly beans (or candies of your choice)

1. Melt bittersweet or white chocolate chips in the microwave, stirring every 30 seconds.
2. When chips are melted, add chow mein noodles and stir to coat.
3. Drop by spoonfuls onto waxed-paper-lined cookie sheet. Form spoonfuls into nest shapes with the tip of your spoon, making sure to leave an indentation in the center for candy eggs.
4. Let set on the counter until nests are cool and hardened. You can also place them in the refrigerator to firm up more quickly.
5. Transfer nests to a serving platter. Place candy eggs in nests and serve.



Makes 6 to 8 nests
