We used Lego[®] building bricks for our key holder, but you can use whatever you have on hand—or under foot.

^IUhat you'll meed

- Lots of building bricks of various colors and shapes
- Large brick baseplate (We used a 10-in. square blue baseplate.)
- About 7 Technic bricks (bricks with holes on sides)
- About 5 key rings
- Twine for hanging

How to make it

- 1. Lay out bricks on a table to spell the word "Dad," or his name or initials (depending on what works best with the bricks you have).
- 2. Center the word on the baseplate and snap on the bricks.
- 3. Snap on 1 Technic brick at each top corner to thread twine through for hanging. Then add a layer of regular bricks on top for support.
- 4. Now add more bricks to create a designed border at the top and the bottom of the baseplate. Be sure to leave room at the bottom so Dad can attach and remove his key rings easily.
- 5. For the key fobs, slide each key ring through a hole of each remaining Technic brick. Add more bricks to the Technic bricks for support. Color code or design each key ring differently so Dad can keep track of each set of keys.
- 6. Now hang it up near the door so Dad will be ready for his next adventure.
