

Pretty Kitty

Crafter level: Easy

Time needed: 30 minutes

What you'll need

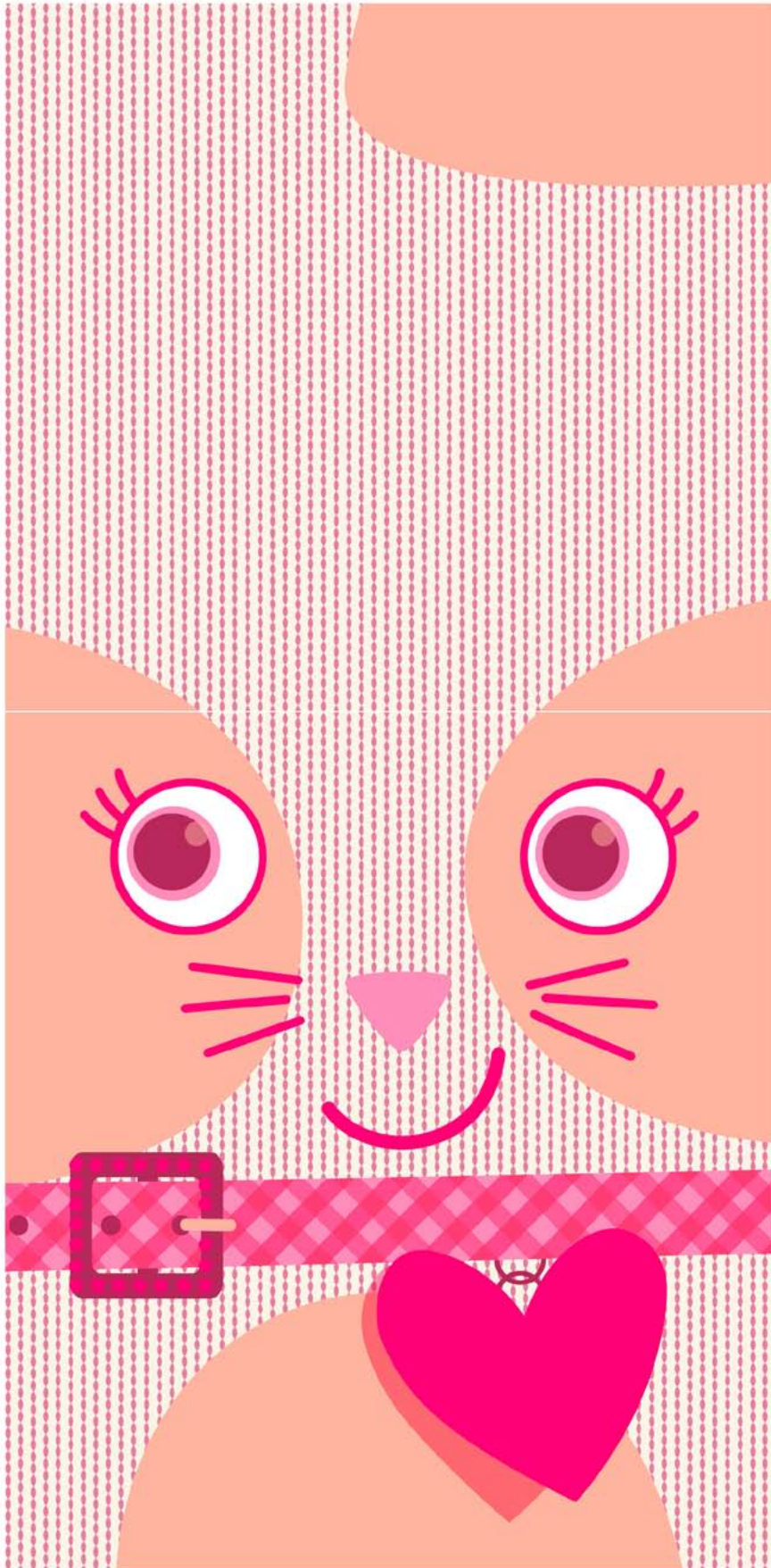
- Empty pop-up tissue box
- Printouts of pretty kitty templates on card stock (for best results)
- Scissors or craft knife
- White glue



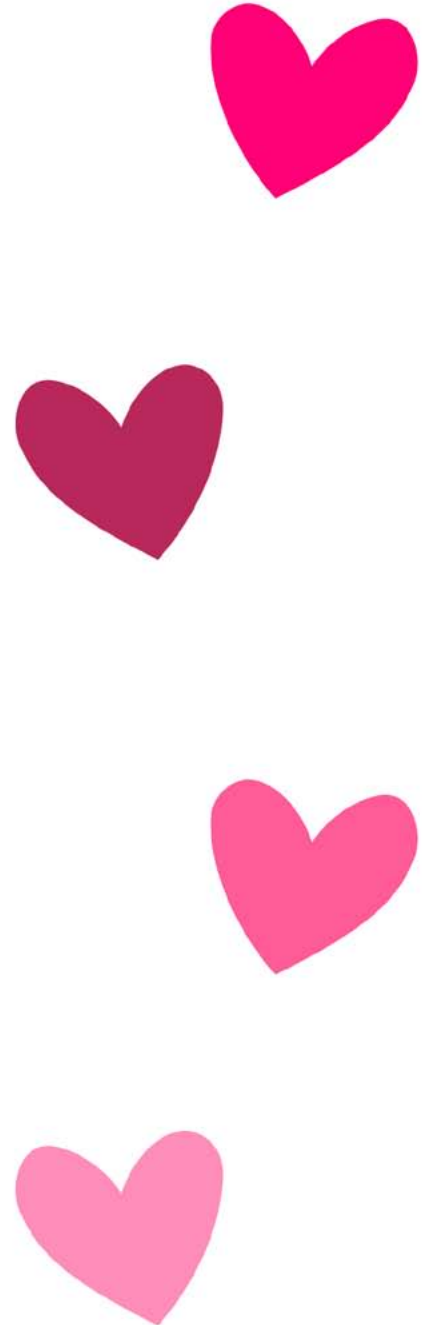
How to make it

1. Cut out pretty kitty's front, back and side panels and glue them, one at a time, to the tissue box. Add your name to the kitty's collar tag on the front panel with a marker or pen (optional).
2. For the top panel, decide the size and shape you want to cut for your opening. Make sure the opening is big enough to fit valentines with candy attached and that it lines up with the opening on the tissue box. Cut out the opening, and then glue the top panel to the top of the box.
3. Cut out the 4 kitty ears and glue them together, front to back. Fold out the flaps and attach them to the top panel of the box, with the fronts of the ears facing forward.
4. Cut out the hearts on the printouts or use your own stickers to add some extra decoration and glitz—until she's just the way you want her!

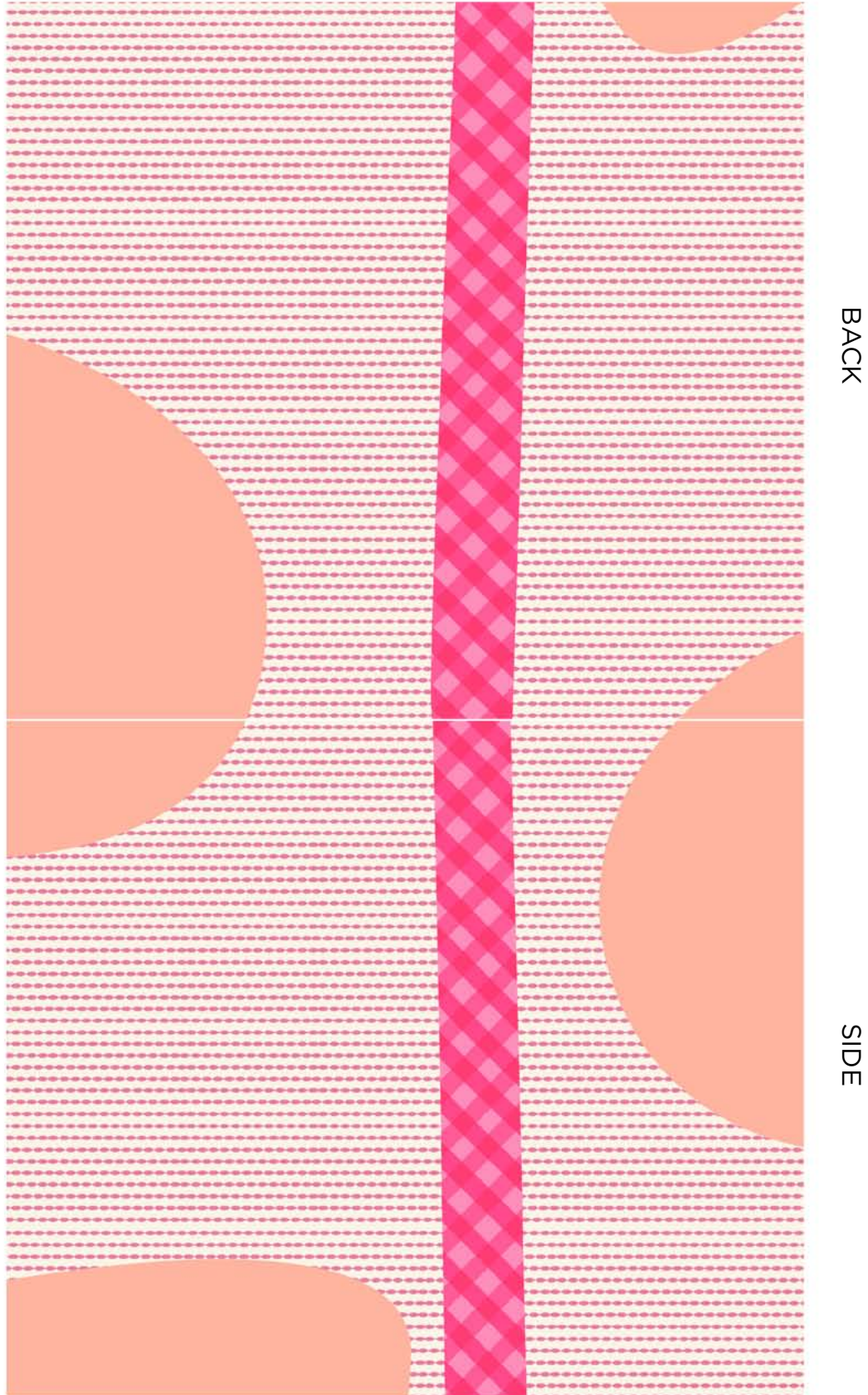

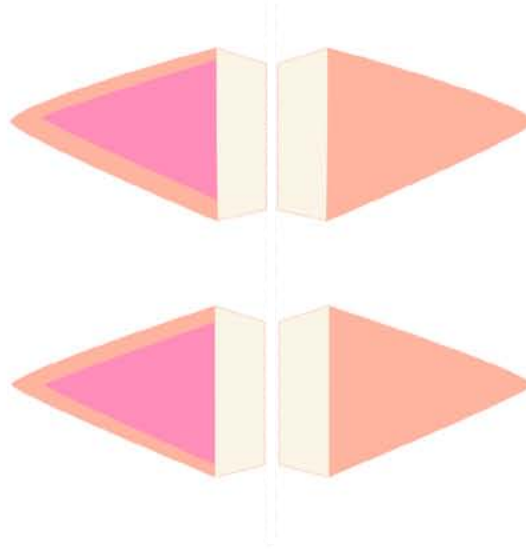

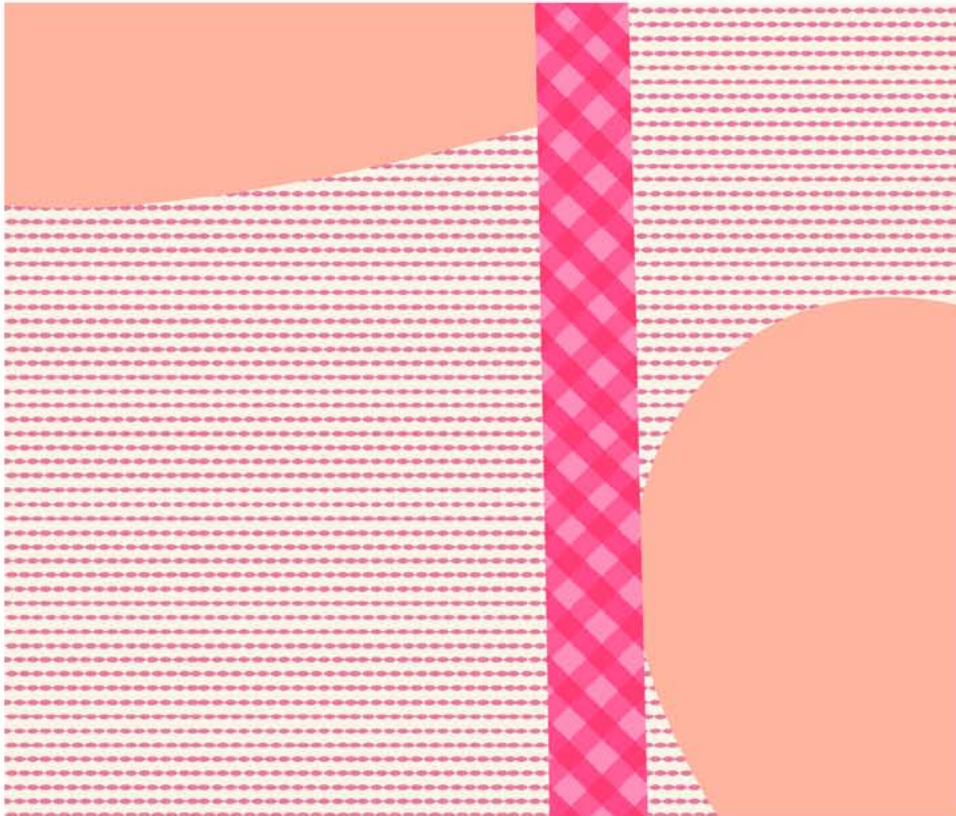
