

Princess Hermosa

Crafter level: Easy

Time needed: 30 minutes

What you'll need

- Tall, empty box (such as a cereal box)
- Printouts of Princess Hermosa templates on card stock (for best results)*
- Scissors or craft knife
- Gift wrap and tape (optional)
- White glue
- String or ribbon (optional)

*Additional sheets of the skirt design have been provided for extra decoration, if needed (optional).

How to make it

1. Cut out the princess's head and body and both arms in the skin tone of your choice. Set aside. Cut out skirt, and either the banner, scepter or string of hearts.
2. Wrap the box with gift wrap in coordinating color such as white or lavender (optional). Cut an opening for the valentines at the top of the box.
Tip: To make a nice rectangular opening, cut a wide "X" shape, and then fold the points to the inside of the box and tape or glue down (See Diagram 1).
3. Glue the head and body and skirt to the side of the box so that the side of the box is completely covered by the princess cutout and let dry.
Tip: The torso is designed to accommodate a variety of box heights. For best results, add the skirt after you've attached the head and body to the box.
4. For the princess's accessories, choose which you'd like to have her hold:
 - Add your name to the banner and attach it to the princess's hands.
 - Or, glue the hearts from the printout to a narrow ribbon or string and then glue the ends of the ribbon to the princess's hands.
 - Or, glue the scepter to one of the princess's hands.
5. Now that her hands have her favorite accessory, glue her arms to her body and let dry. There, now Princess Hermosa is ready to receive guests and accept valentines. Don't forget to curtsy!

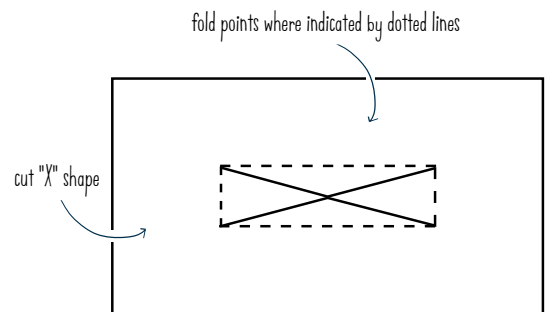
