

# Good Clean Fun Soaps

*These are so simple and fun to make, you'll need to throw another party so you can make more.*

**Crafter level:** Easy

**Time needed:** About 1 hour

## What you'll need

- Microwaveable bowl
- Melt-and-pour soap base
- Disposable plastic spoons
- Soap molds (We used heart shapes.)
- Petroleum jelly
- Knife
- Essential oils for fragrance
- Soap dyes (in colors of your choice)
- Spray bottle filled with rubbing alcohol (for removing air bubbles)
- Small cellophane bags
- Good Clean Fun printables on card stock
- Stapler
- Eyedroppers (if not included with dyes and oils)



## How to make it

1. Cut the melt-and-pour soap base into small pieces (about 1-inch square) with a knife. Put soap pieces into the microwaveable bowl and microwave in 30-second increments until the pieces have melted completely.
2. While soap is in microwave, lightly coat the inside of the molds with petroleum jelly. (We used a paper towel to evenly distribute it.)
3. Remove the soap from the microwave. Add a few drops of essential oil to the soap and stir. Add more if desired.
4. Add a few drops of dye to the soap and stir again. Repeat until it's the shade you want.
5. Pour the melted soap carefully into the molds. Spray the tops of the soaps with a light mist of rubbing alcohol to smooth out any remaining air bubbles.
6. Let the soaps cool on the countertop for about an hour until they're completely hardened. Flip the molds over and pop the soaps out of the molds.
7. To make the bags, print out the soap hangtag template on card stock, and cut them to the width of your cellophane bags (if necessary). Score and fold in half. Add a soap to each bag and top it with a folded hangtag. Staple together to seal.
