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Fabric-covered Button Boutonniere Pins

Tip: Make sure your fabric is not too sheer (or the metal of the button will show through) and not too thick (or the fabric will pucker on the edges).

Crafter level: Easy

"What you'll need for I pins

- Button-cover kit (available at craft stores)
- 2 scraps of fabric, each about 3-in. diameter
- ¼ yd. 1-in. wide ribbon
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks or strong craft glue
- 2 pin backs



How to make it

- 1. Use the instructions on the button-cover kit and the fabric scraps to create the buttons.
- 2. Cut the ribbon in half and trim both ends of each piece of ribbon at an angle. Find the center of each piece of ribbon and glue each piece to the back of a button.
- 3. Glue a pin back to the back of each button.
