Paper Rosette Boutonniere Pins

Crafter level: Easy

What you'll need for I pins

- 1 sheet heavy weight paper in color of your choice
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks or strong craft glue
- 2 craft jewels
- 1 felt square
- Pinking shears
- ¼ yd. burlap ribbon
- 2 pin backs



How to make it

- 1. For each rosette, cut a small rectangle from the heavy weight paper. (Our rectangles were a little smaller than a dollar bill—about 2 by 6 inches in size).
- 2. Accordion-fold the rectangles down their length using ¼-inch folds.
- 3. Fold each strip in half and glue the 2 joined sides together to form a half circle. Let dry. Then glue the remaining 2 open sides together to form the full-circle rosettes. Keep edges pinched together until the glue is completely dry.
- 4. Glue a craft jewel to the center of each rosette.
- 5. Cut 2, 2½-inch circles from the felt using the pinking shears.
- 6. Cut the burlap ribbon into 2 pieces. Fold each $4\frac{1}{2}$ -inch piece in half, pinch, and glue the center of each ribbon to the back of a paper rosette. Trim the ribbon ends at an angle.
- 7. Center and glue the backside of each rosette to a felt circle. Glue a pin back to the back of each felt circle.
