

Rosette Trio

Crafter level: Easy

What you'll need

- 3 sheets of scrapbook paper in wedding colors of your choice, plus 3 small pieces of scrap paper in complementary colors
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- 3 cake pop sticks
- Circle punches (we used 1½-in. and 1¼-in. scalloped circles and a 1-in. non-scalloped circle)

How to make it

1. Cut 3 small circles out of 3 pieces of scrapbook paper in varying sizes.
2. Cut a long rectangle from 1 sheet of scrapbook paper in whatever length you'd like. (We used 2, 5-by-10-inch rectangles and 1, 7-by-12-inch rectangle.) Accordion-fold the paper (we used $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch folds), and then fold the strip in half and glue the 2 sides together to form a half circle. Let dry. Then glue the remaining 2 open sides together to form the full-circle rosette. Keep edges pinched together until the glue is completely dry.
3. Glue 1 of the cut circles to the center of the rosette. This will help hold it flat. Be sure to press it down on a flat surface when gluing, and let the hot glue set. Then glue the cake pop stick to the back of the rosette.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the remaining rosettes.
5. Insert the cake pop sticks into the cake at varying angles and heights to give the full effect to the rosettes.
