



# Wedding Ring Toss

**Crafter level:** Easy

## What you'll need

- 12 tall, clear glass bottles, all approximately the same height
- Craft paint in colors of your choice for bottles (we used mint, navy, coral and gold)
- 12 cork bottle-stoppers (optional)
- Printouts of number labels in silver and/or gold
- Double-sided tape
- Crate to fit all 12 bottles (4 columns wide by 3 rows deep)
- Black chalkboard paint
- Gold or silver chalk paint pen
- 6, 3-in. diameter wood embroidery hoops
- Craft paint in white and silver or gold for rings
- 1/8-in.-thick sheet of balsa wood



- Craft knife and cutting mat
- Paintbrushes
- Silver or gold metallic marker
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Small adhesive jewels

## How to make it

### For the bottles

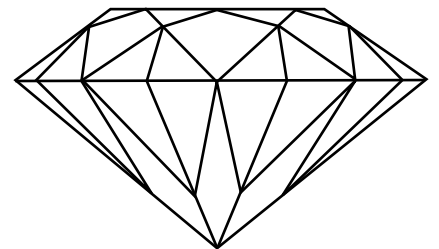
1. Paint the insides of the bottles: Squirt small amounts of the craft paint into the bottles, turning the bottles around and around to coat the insides completely with paint. Turn the bottles upside down to drain excess paint. Let dry. Repeat with a second coat of paint, if necessary. Once completely dry, add the stoppers to the bottles (optional).
2. Cut out the gold or silver (or both) number labels 1 through 4 from the printouts and attach numbers to 4 of the bottles with double-sided tape.

### For the crate

1. Paint inset on side of crate with black chalkboard paint and let dry. Repaint with a second coat and let dry overnight.
2. Use chalk paint pen to write "Ring Toss" on chalkboard. Set crate aside.

### For the rings

1. Separate the inside and outside rings of the embroidery hoops and set aside the outside rings (you only need the inside rings). Paint all 6 inside rings with silver or gold paint. Let dry and repaint if necessary to cover completely.
2. Cut out diamond template at right and place it on the sheet of balsa wood. Cut out using a craft knife. Cut 3 diamond shapes from the wood.
3. Paint the diamond wood shapes white on both sides and edges. Once dry, add the outline of the diamond pattern with gold or silver metallic marker.
4. Glue the tips of the 3 wood diamonds to 3 rings with hot glue. Add adhesive jewels around the outsides of all the rings.
